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## "News from the WE Project: Real World Education - We continue our educational journey with enthusiasm!"

WE: Real World Education is an Erasmus+ project co-financed by the European Union.

The project WE: Real World Education has reached a significant milestone with the successful conclusion of Work Package 3 (WP3). We would like to share with you the results of the completed activities and give you an update.

## **Accomplished Results**

In accordance with the set objectives, the partnership completed the following activities, which were included in WP3:

**Development of the Inclusive Curriculum:** We have created the WE Curriculum on Environmental Awareness and Sustainable Development in Adult Education (AE), which includes 10 modules. This curriculum is designed to develop green skills among low-skilled adults on a professional and personal level.



**Educational and Training Modules:** We developed educational modules and provided training to AE trainers. These modules improve trainers' teaching skills in the use of inclusive methods concerning Environmental Awareness, Climate Change, Sustainable Development and the SDGs.

**Equipment of AE Trainers:** We provided AE trainers with knowledge and skills to teach lowskilled adults, promoting sustainable lifestyles and encouraging sustainable community management.

**Focus Groups and Curriculum Evaluation:** Parallel to the development of the curriculum, we conducted in-depth focus groups to evaluate its effectiveness and gather feedback from our stakeholders. This evaluation allowed us to further refine the curriculum to better meet the needs of our target audience. During this phase, 3-8 local participants from each focus group validated the finalised WE Curriculum. Each partner had a meeting with them (online or on-site) to gather their feedback on the quality and usefulness of the WE Curriculum.

After the focus group meetings, the results of their evaluations, together with the evaluations of the partners and the external quality expert, were used to further improve the project results.

**Second TPM in Zaragoza - December 2023:** We would also like to share that in December 2023, we successfully conducted the Second Transnational Project Meeting (TPM) in Zaragoza. During this meeting, we discussed recent developments in the project, analysed the results of the activities carried out and planned the next steps for WP4.
