The project WE: Real World Education has entered Work Package 4 phase (WP4). We are pleased to present our results reached so far to you.

Accomplished Results: After implementing the WE curriculum on Environmental Awareness, the partnership completed the following activities, which were included in WP4:

Creation of the e-learning platform: The main objective of WP4 was the creation of an e-learning platform designed to implement the training curricula developed in the previous WP. This platform aims to facilitate learning through an interactive approach, making it easier and more engaging to acquire knowledge about the environment, climate, and how to achieve proper green education. By using this interactive methodology, users can effectively and enjoyably delve into essential sustainability topics, developing greater awareness and skills necessary to address the environmental challenges of our time.















Developing of 10 interactive training modules: We created educational modules and enhancing teaching skills with inclusive methods focused on Environmental Awareness, Climate Change, Sustainable Development, and the SDGs. These modules are designed to elevate trainers' abilities to effectively educate on these critical topics.

Establish a system to recognise learnings outcomes: We have developed a system to establish and validate learning outcomes through Open Badges, aligned with the ESCO framework. This system provides verifiable credentials that document the skills acquired by participants. These certificates can be utilized by adults as additional competencies since they hold recognized value.

Focus on the support of vulnerable communities: To empower vulnerable communities, we have designed specialised educational tools aimed at integrating SDG skills into Adult Education, focusing particularly on NEETs and socially or economically marginalised groups. These tools are crafted to provide practical knowledge and competencies that not only enhance personal development but also foster sustainability practices for the broader community and environment. It is essential to recognise that equipping NEET individuals with these skills, contributes positively to building a more resilient and sustainable future for society as a whole.

Knowledge Hub Testing Phase: We are excited to announce that the testing phase of our Knowledge Hub is ongoing. This hub is available in all partner languages and aims to provide comprehensive resources and support to educators and learners alike. For more information, visit our website.
